NOTICE INVITING TENDER FOR SETTLEMENT OF FOREIGN LIQUOR BONDED
WAREHOUSE UNDER WEST TRIPURA DISTRICT.

It is hereby notified for general information that licence(s) is proposed to be offered for Bonded Warehouse at the place noted below through tender method for the financial year 2017-18.

2. Intending tenderer shall quote the bid money both in figures and in words in plain paper in tender application addressed to the Collector of Excise, West Tripura District, Agartala in *sealed cover*. *The bid money to be quoted in the tender shall have to be more than the minimum reserve fee fixed against the broad area where Foreign Liquor Bonded Warehouse is proposed to be established. The tender shall be sent by the tenderer by registered post so as to reach the office of the Collector of Excise, West Tripura District, Agartala within 15(fifteen) days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tripura Gazette.*

3. The tender quoting the bid shall be submitted along with the following documents:-

- (a). Attested copy of the citizenship certificate of the bidder.
- (b). Attested copy of the permanent resident certificate of the bidder.
- (c). Receipt copy of the treasury challan (Head of A/c for deposit 0039- State Excise) or Bank Draft on any branch of the State Bank of India for 50% of the bid money quoted by him/her for the Bonded Warehouse (Head of A/c for deposit 0039- State Excise)
- (d). A statement of immovable property and current bank balance to prove that he/she is financially able to carry on the business.

(e). A certificate from the concerned Bank Manager about the present bank balance of the tenderer giving the account number etc or the Bank Manager may certify the tenderer's ability to carry on the business.

(f). The tenderer shall submit the details of location and description of the building(owned/hired) with other necessary infrastructure facilities proposed for running the Bonded Warehouse. The proposed building for establishment of bonded warehouse should not be situated within a radius of 100 meters from any religious place like Temple, Ashram and Mosque etc.

(g). Income Tax, Sales tax & Professional Tax clearance certificate.

(h).The bidder shall himself certify that he/she never been convicted by a criminal court for committing any non-bailable offence.

(i). A declaration is to be submitted by the tenderer that he/she is not a former licensee or he/she was a former licensee but not having any arrear dues to be paid to the Government and his/her conduct has not been found to be unsatisfactory and that he/she never been found guilty of any serious breach of conditions of license. If any one of the above listed documents are not submitted or there is concealment of fact, the tender will be summarily rejected.

4. The person selected for granting a license shall have to deposit the balance of the tendered value (bid money) and the annual license fee as fixed by the state Government within 7(seven) days from receipt of such direction from the Collector of Excise. In the event of failure to deposit the same, within the specified period, his/her tender is liable to be cancelled and 50% of the bid money already deposited at the time of submitting the tender will be forfeited.

5. The Collector of Excise shall depute adequate Excise staff, at least one Senior Inspector/Sub Inspector of Excise & one Excise Guard to look after the work of Bonded Warehouse and also to check up the consignment of liquor/India Made Foreign Liquor & Beer imported in the warehouse and the successful tenderer shall have to pay to the Government:-

(a). In advance a fee in cash equivalent to the estimated cost of such officers and establishment for 3(three) months as the Excise commissioner may fix.

(b). Monthly a fee in cash equivalent to the monthly cost which the Excise Commissioner may fix, within 7(Seven) days after the expiry of the month to which the fee relates.
